Year: 6

<b>SUBJECT</b>	<b>Termly Overview</b>
<b>RE</b>	<b>Journeys</b> –the children will explore their experience of life as a journey. They hear about Christian life as the Church family journeying with Jesus. <b>Communion</b> – the children will explore what makes and breaks communion (friendship). They learn about the Eucharist challenging and enabling people to live and grow in communion every day. <b>Growing</b> – the children will explore their own potential for growth. They learn about Lent, Holy Week and Easter as the Church's seasons for working at spiritual growth and celebrating Jesus fully alive..
<b>PSHE</b>	Children will learn about resolving conflicts peacefully and the need for personal responsibility in the process of becoming more independent
<b>English.</b>	<b>Reading</b> - children will review different types of fiction and factual texts and their structure and language features <b>Writing</b> - children will use the models of different text types to enable them to write using the appropriate structure and language features. They will also consolidate their understanding of punctuation, paragraphing and spelling of common words and letter patterns <b>SATS</b> - children will revise the main concepts covered in the KS2 curriculum in preparation for SATS
<b>Maths</b>	Children will revise their number knowledge and recall of number facts. They will review 2D and 3D shapes along with using metric units of measurement and will use and apply this knowledge in problem solving <b>SATS</b> - children will revise the main concepts covered in the KS2 curriculum in preparation for SATS

<b>ICT</b>	Children will use ICT to access software and websites to review their English, Maths and Science knowledge.
<b>PE</b>	Children will learn about different dance styles and work in groups to devise dance routines on set topics. They will also participate in Striking and Fielding and Invasion games.
<b>French</b>	The children will revise previous vocabulary, different ways of writing the date, sentences starters. Tables and mental maths in French. Paintings by French artists. They will read stories, sing traditional French songs and finger rhymes.
<b>Music</b>	The children will listen to and learn hymns for school assemblies and Masses. They will study part singing, Gospel music and the work of famous composers.
<b>Science</b>	<p><b>Dissolving</b> - children will learn about how materials change state and how there are reversible and irreversible changes</p> <p><b>Electricity</b> - children will learn about circuits and how to record them as circuit diagrams.</p> <p><b>Forces- children</b> will learn how to measure forces and will look at different types of forces and how they act on objects.</p> <p><b>Revision</b> - children will revise the main concepts taught at KS2 in preparation for <b>SATS</b></p>
